# **PKAVS**

<u>PKAVS</u> is a small charity with a big heart working tirelessly to improve lives and connect communities throughout Perth and Kinross. They help over 5,000 local people through their 5 hubs - Carers, Minority Communities, Third Sector and Volunteering, and Mental Health and Wellbeing.

The charity is diverse, supporting people from many backgrounds, of all ages, and with cast differing needs. They work alongside the NHS, local council, government, and voluntary bodies to help as many people as they can achieve their goals and recognise their potential.

Since becoming accredited as a Living Wage Employer in 2017, PKAVS have proudly promoted their achievement across various different platforms and channels.

To celebrate their accreditation, PKAVS coordinated a photoshoot with local press with staff members and volunteers holding the Living Wage logo sign. This was featured alongside a story in the local newspaper.

About their accreditation, Chief Executive Paul Graham said "We in PKAVS are delighted to be accredited as a Living Wage employer. Our Employees are our greatest asset and whilst securing funding is always a challenge for charities we think it is vitally important to make sure our employees are paid at least



the Living Wage and we would hope that all employers in Perth & Kinross will follow suit."

In their second year as a Living Wage Employer, PKAVS did a press feature to promote their nomination in the Living Wage Champion Awards 2018 and in the Family Friendly Scotland Awards.
